***CAMPUS RECREATION
MEMBERSHIP POLICIES
Updated October 2009***

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1.0 General Information

1.1 Definitions

1.1.1 Semester / Term

The fall and spring semester start dates are dictated by the University of Arizona Schedule. For membership purposes the fall semester ends on the first day of spring semester. The spring semester ends on the Monday after May commencement. The summer semester begins the Monday after May commencement and ends on the day before classes begin of the fall semester as set by the University. There are *three* semesters in each year and *four* terms – fall semester is term 4, spring semester is term 1 and summer semester has two terms – 2 and 3.

1.1.2 Annual Membership

The Annual Membership (\$250.00) is based on a calendar year from the date of purchase and is a cost saving over the semester membership of \$35.00 a year.

1.1.3 Annual Plus Membership

The Annual Plus Membership (\$330.00) is based on a calendar year from the date of purchase and can be purchased at any time. The Annual Plus Membership is \$80.00 more than the regular Annual Membership price and includes an annual locker and towel service.

1.1.4 Campus Recreation Membership

Membership entitles users to the use of all Campus Recreation facilities - Student Recreation Center and the Robson Tennis Center. Organized programs, such as fitness classes, activity classes, aquatic classes, outdoor adventure trips and intramurals plus any other programs not mentioned herein are available to members at an additional cost.

1.2 Memberships are not transferable nor are they refundable.

1.3 Misuse of membership or facilities may result in the membership being revoked.

1.4 Facilities and services will be available on a regular basis, however they may be discontinued for a given period of time because of directives from the University, major maintenance projects, inclement weather or other unforeseen circumstances. Memberships are not pro-rated because of these events.

1.5 Campus Recreation Identification

Members are required to show their **current, active CatCard** in order to access the facility, to access any services, to make any purchases and to make any changes to their current member record. A new member (excluding members issued a Campus Recreation Temporary Card) who does not have a CatCard will be able to use their paid receipt and 'CatCard Authorization' form, along with a picture I.D. for one week to gain access instead of their CatCard. After the one week, the CatCard will be required. CatCards are available from the CatCard Office located in Student Union, north of the food court. The cost for the card as of this revision date is \$25.00.

CatCards used by someone other than the owner will be confiscated. Confiscated CatCards will be turned over to the Dean of Students for appropriate action. If the owner is not a student, Campus Recreation will contact the owner's supervisor for appropriate disciplinary actions.

Members who are issued a Campus Recreation **Temporary Card** must present the Temporary Card along with a picture ID to enter facilities.

1.6 Ejected Participants

Members who are ejected from a program or facility will lose privileges to all programs and facilities until such time that they are re-instated by the Department's Judicial Board. The ejected participants must submit a written request for re-instatement 24 hours before the Board meets and must meet with the Board during their regularly scheduled meeting time. Disciplinary sanctions from the Board begin from the time of the Board's meeting with the participant not from the time of the incident.

1.7 Student Recreation Center Bond Retirement Fee

In 1985, the students of the University of Arizona voted to assess themselves a \$25.00 *per-semester* fee for the construction of a Student Recreation Center. This fee came into effect in Fall 1990.

In 2005, the students of the University of Arizona voted in support of the continuation of the current \$25.00 per semester student recreation bond fee for an additional 30 years to pay for a facility expansion. The extension was then approved at the March 2006 ABOR meeting.

Although this fee is mandatory, it will cease once the bonds have been retired, therefore it is not a user fee.

Recreation Center Bond Retirement Fee Waivers will be granted for specific reasons. Guidelines for requesting a Recreation Center Bond Retirement Fee Waiver are available at Student Recreation Center, Recreation Services and online at <http://CampusRec.arizona.edu>.

1.8 Campus Recreation Program Fee

In March of 2002, the students of the University of Arizona voted to assess themselves a \$3.00 *per term* Program Fee that is refundable and continuous with a CPI (Consumer Price Index - increases annually, effective increase first day of the fall semester) to assist with the funding of Campus Recreation programs.

For students (undergraduate and graduate) enrolled in four units or more during the fall and spring, or three units or more during the summer, the deadline for submitting the refund request is before the 1st day of class of the current semester. For CESL, Semester Previous, Continuing Education, ASU/NAU, Non-UA (summer only) and Medical (summer only) students a request for a waiver of the Campus Recreation Program Fee must be made at the time the membership is purchased at the Department of Campus Recreation – Recreation Services for the current term. Guidelines for requesting a waiver and forms are available at Recreation Services (lobby area) of Campus Recreation and online at <http://CampusRec.arizona.edu>.

2.0 Current University Student

2.1 Eligibility

A student is anyone (minor or adult) who is enrolled in one or more units at the University of Arizona during the current semester is eligible for membership. Students must show their current, active CatCard in order to access the facility, to access any services, to make any purchases and to make any changes to their current member record.

UA students (*undergraduate and graduate*) enrolled in four units or more during the fall and spring semester do not have to pay anything outside of their tuition and fees to be a member since the Recreation Center Bond Retirement Fee will be accepted as payment for membership. During the summer semester, since there are two terms (session 1 - includes pre-session and session 2) a student enrolled in three units or more during either session do not have to pay anything outside of their tuition and fees to be a member since the Recreation Center Bond Retirement Fee will be accepted as payment for membership. The Recreation Center Bond Retirement Fee is posted to student's bursar account each semester.

UA students taking 3 (three) units or less during the fall (term 1) and spring (term 2), or 2 (two) units or less during the summer (terms 2 and 3) are eligible for membership to Campus Recreation facilities. UA students with 3 (three) units or less during the fall (term 1) and spring semester (term 2) and 2 (two) units or less during the summer semester for both (terms 2 and 3) must pay a fee at the Student Recreation Center - Recreation Services (lobby area) in order to access the facilities. Membership fees are \$40.00 per semester.

2.2 Continuation Education Students

Students enrolled at the Office of Continuing Education must meet the UA academic qualifications of a credited course for either an Extended University course or a Correspondence to be eligible for a Campus Recreation membership. The student must bring picture identification and must be taking a credited course that is verifiable via SIS (Student Information System).

The membership will be valid for the semester in which the student is enrolled and is allotted to finish the course. Upon purchase of the membership, the student will be issued a Temporary Membership Card unless the student has a current active CatCard previously issued by the CatCard office with them at the time the membership is purchased. If the student is issued a Temporary Card the card must be presented along with a picture i.d. to access the building.

2.2.1 Membership Term

Students are only eligible to sign up for one current semester at a time.

2.2.2 Students who are not automatically assessed the Student Recreation Center Fee can pay the membership fee at Recreation Services (lobby area). The price per semester is \$43.56 for spring and fall. Fall and spring semester pricing includes a Campus Recreation Program Fee, of which you can request a waiver – per term only. For the summer semester the price is \$47.12 for the entire semester or \$23.56 for either summer term. Summer pricing includes a per term Campus Recreation Program Fee, of which you can request a per term, summer waiver*. (*see section 1.8 for further information)

2.2.3 Payment Options

Fees may be paid by cash, check, debit, Bursar's Account, American Express, Visa, or MasterCard. Students are only eligible to sign up for one semester at a time.

Disclaimer: Campus Recreation is unable to accept Bursar's Account payments effective fall 2008 semester.

2.3 Special Student Memberships

CESL Students

Students registered for the Center for English as a Second Language program for the current semester are eligible for membership. The day or evening CESL students may have a current, active CatCard or they **may not**. The CESL program does not require their students to purchase a CatCard. CESL students that do not have a CatCard will be issued a Temporary Card.

CESL students must show the current semester CESL card along with a picture ID to purchase membership. CESL students must show their current, active CatCard (if applicable) in order to access the facility, to access any services, to make any purchases and to make any changes to their current member record. If a Temporary Card is issued, the student must show the Temporary Card and a picture I.D. to access the facility, to access any services, to make any purchases and to make any changes to their current member record.

ASU/NAU and NON-UA or Visiting/Living in Tucson Semester Students

Students enrolled at ASU, NAU or any other non-UA (4 year) university during the current semester but are in Tucson for the semester are eligible for membership. The student must bring picture identification, must be taking credited classes from their university and must provide a current semester fees paid receipt that includes their name and current semester date.

The membership will be valid for the current semester in which the student is enrolled. Upon purchase of the membership, the student will be issued a Campus Recreation Temporary Card and must present the Temporary Card along with a picture ID in order to enter facilities. Should the student have a current, active CatCard with them at the time of membership purchase, the member's current, active CatCard will be used and a Temporary Card will not be issued.

2.3.1 Membership Term

Students are only eligible to sign up for one current semester at a time.

2.3.2 Membership Price

Those who are not automatically assessed the Student Recreation Center Fee can pay the membership fee at the Campus Recreation, Recreation Services (lobby area). The price per semester is \$43.56 for spring and fall. Fall and spring semester pricing includes a Campus Recreation Program Fee, of which you can request a waiver – per term only. For the summer semester the price is \$47.12 for the entire semester or \$23.56 for either summer term. Summer pricing includes a per term Campus Recreation Program Fee, of which you can request a per term, summer waiver*. ([*see section 1.8 for further information](#))

2.3.4 Payment Options

Fees may be paid by cash, check, debit, American Express, Visa, or MasterCard.

3.0 PCC/UA Joint Admission and Enrollment Program Student

3.1 Eligibility

All PCC/UA Joint admission students are eligible for membership in the Department of Campus Recreation. [A list of these students will be provided to Campus Recreation in order to verify the student's enrollment in the PCC/UA Joint Admission and Enrollment program.](#)

Campus Recreation membership entitles Joint Admission students use of all Campus Recreation facilities - Student Recreation Center and the Robson Tennis Center. Organized programs such as fitness classes, activity classes, outdoor adventure trips and intramurals are available to Joint Admission students, as with all UA Students, at an additional cost. Students must show their [current, active CatCard](#) in order to access the facility, to access any services, to make any purchases and to make any changes to their current member record.

PCC/UA Joint Admission students enrolled in four units or more at the University of Arizona during the fall and spring, or three units or more during the summer semester sessions do not have to pay anything outside of their tuition and fees to be a member since the mandatory Recreation Center Bond Retirement Fee of \$25.00 plus \$3.56 per term for the [Refundable Program Fee*](#), is accepted as payment for membership. The Recreation Center Bond Retirement Fee and Program Fee are automatically posted to student's bursar's account each semester. ([*see section 1.8 for further information](#))

PCC/UA Joint Admission students taking three units or less during the fall and spring and two units or less during the summer semester sessions are not automatically assessed the Student Recreation Center Fee but are still eligible for membership at Campus Recreation. Those students must pay the membership fee directly to Campus Recreation, Recreation Services (lobby area). The price per semester is \$43.56 for spring and fall. This price includes a \$3.56 Campus Recreation Program Fee, of which you can request a [waiver*](#) – per term only. ([*see section 1.8 for further information](#))

For the summer semester the price is \$47.12 for the entire semester or \$23.56 for either summer term. Summer pricing includes a \$3.56 per term Campus Recreation Program Fee, of which a request for a [waiver*](#) of the Campus Recreation Program Fee – per term – must be made at the time the

membership is purchased at the Department of Campus Recreation, Recreation Services (lobby area). (*see section 1.8 for further information)

Memberships are not transferable nor are they refundable. Misuse of membership or facilities may result in the membership being revoked.

3.2 Payment Options

Fees may be paid by cash, check, debit, American Express, Visa, or MasterCard.

4.0 Current and Retired University Employee

4.1 Eligibility

Any adult (18 years of age and older – *non-student employee*) currently employed by or retired from The University of Arizona is eligible for membership.

The employee and retiree must present their current, active CatCard in order to access the facility, to access any services, to make any purchases and to make any change to their current member record.

4.2 Membership Term

Employees and Retirees are eligible to sign up for one semester at a time or annually.

4.3 Membership Price

The price per Semester Membership is \$95.00; Annual Memberships are \$250.00 and Annual Plus Memberships are \$330.00. Membership fees can be paid at the Campus Recreation, Recreation Services.

4.4 Payment Options

Fees can be paid by cash, check, debit, American Express, Visa, MasterCard or via Payroll Deduction (see next paragraph).

Payroll Deduction

Only current, permanent benefits eligible faculty/classified staff employees of the University of Arizona are qualified to utilize payroll deduction. The payroll deduction option for employees with less than .75 FTE may be discontinued at any time at the discretion of the Department of Campus Recreation. Payroll deduction memberships are ongoing, meaning that they do not expire. Employees opting for this membership are required to continue the membership for one year due to the one year Payroll Deduction contractual obligation. After the first year, the membership will continue until the member completes (in writing) a Payroll Deduction cancellation form and submits said form to the Department of Campus Recreation. Cancellation forms are available at Recreation Services of Campus Recreation. The payroll deduction rate is based upon the Annual Membership rate or Annual Plus rate - divided by the number of deduction-eligible paychecks the employee receives each year. The current cost for an employee on a 12-month contract is \$10.42 (annual) or \$13.75 (Annual Plus) per paycheck. The current cost for an employee on a 9-month contract is \$13.89 (Annual) or \$18.34 (Annual Plus) per paycheck.

5.0 Current University Affiliate Institution Employee

5.1 Eligibility

UA Provost Approved Affiliate Institutions

Any adult (18 years old or older) currently employed by an UA Provost approved Affiliate institution of the University of Arizona may be eligible for membership. The Affiliate institution must be listed on the current UA Provost Approved Affiliate institutions List and the Affiliate employee must be verifiable as (F = Affiliated) status on the UA's PSOS employee database in order to purchase a membership – except for the following noted Affiliates.

A current pay stub is required for **University Physicians, Inc.** and **Pima Community College** employees in order to purchase a membership. (current – pay stub dated within 30 days of date of membership purchase)

Religious Affiliates

Any adult (18 years old or older) currently employed by an approved Religious Affiliate of the University of Arizona may be eligible for membership. The Religious Affiliate must be approved by and listed on the current University Religious Counsel (URC) list and the approved religious affiliate employee must provide a letter on their religious affiliate's letterhead stating their name verifying employment status -or- a current religious affiliate employee list with said name must be on file at Recreation Services in order to purchase a membership.

5.2 Membership Term

Affiliate employees are eligible to sign up for one semester at a time or annually as long as their Affiliate employment is current for the duration of the semester or annual membership purchased.

5.3 Membership Price

The price per semester is \$95.00 or \$250.00 annually or \$330.00 for annual plus. Membership fees can be paid at the Campus Recreation, Recreation Services (lobby area). Upon purchase of the membership, the member will have one week to purchase a CatCard from the University CatCard Office.

5.4 Payment Options

Fees can be paid by cash, check, debit, American Express, Visa or MasterCard.

6.0 Visiting Scholar/Faculty and Visiting Student

6.1 Visiting Scholars/Faculty

Faculty (18 years old or older) on the Visiting Scholars Program qualify for temporary membership. A picture identification and either a Visiting Scholar ID card or a letter from the department head (on UA department letterhead) specifically stating the dates of employment, name and visiting status (i.e. *Visiting Scholar, Visiting Faculty, Visiting Professor*) are required to purchase a membership.

Visiting Scholars/Faculty are eligible to sign up for one current semester at a time or annually based on the length of time the visitor will be on campus as noted on visitor id card or letter from UA department.

6.2 Visiting Students

Students attending another university, but their current class is located at the University of Arizona are eligible for temporary membership. A picture identification and either a Visiting Student ID card or a letter from the department head (on UA department letterhead) specifically stating the dates of study, name and visiting status (*Visiting Student*) are required to purchase a membership. **Visiting Students are eligible to sign up for one current semester at a time based upon the length of time the visitor will be on campus as noted in visitor id card or letter from UA department.**

6.3 Membership Terms

Membership terms vary based upon the length of time the visitor will be on campus. Depending on how long the visitor will be on campus, the visitor will have one week to purchase a CatCard from the University CatCard Office. **Please refer to 6.1 and 6.2 for additional information relating to Visting Scholars/Faculty and Visiting Students membership terms.**

Should the assigned department not issue the Visiting Scholar, Faculty or Visiting Student a CatCard during their visit, Campus Recreation will issue a Temporary Card at the time of purchase. The Temporary Card along with a picture ID would need to be presented in order to enter facilities.

6.4 Membership Prices

The prices noted below are based on the length of time per semester. The following scale will be used:

**A \$3.56 per term Campus Recreation Program Fee will be added to your membership price, of which you can request a per term waiver*. 6.5 Payment Options

Fees can be paid by cash, check, debit, American Express, Visa, or MasterCard.

7.0 Alumni Membership

7.1 Eligibility

All UA alumni and current Alumni Association members who are 18 years old or older are eligible for an Annual membership at Campus Recreation. All alumni must present picture identification at time of enrollment. The alumni must be verified as a UA graduate on UA's SIS database (Student Information System) to purchase a membership. If Recreation Services is unable to verify via SIS then the Alumni must provide either an unofficial UA transcript (free from the Bursar's office) or a copy of their UA diploma to purchase an Alumni membership.

The Alumni Association member must present their current Alumni Association membership card at time of purchase along with picture identification. The membership card must include the member's printed name and current Alumni Association membership dates. The membership dates must be current/active for the same length of time as the Campus Recreation Annual Alumni membership.

7.2 Membership Terms and Prices

7.2.1 Alumni Gold Annual Membership

The Alumni Gold Annual Membership provides members with unlimited access to the Student Recreation Center and includes a locker and towel service. The annual price is \$369.00. Membership fees can be paid at Recreation Services (lobby area) . Upon purchase of the membership, the member will have one week to purchase a CatCard from the University CatCard Office.

7.2.2 Alumni Limited Silver Annual Membership

The Alumni Limited Silver Annual Membership includes locker and towel service and provides members with limited access to the Student Recreation Center (Mon - Fri 6am to 12 noon; Fri 7pm to Close and Sat & Sun all day). The annual price is \$259.00. Membership fees can be paid at the Recreation Services (lobby area). Upon purchase of the membership, the member will have one week to purchase a CatCard from the University CatCard Office.

7.3 Payment Options

Fees can be paid by cash, check, debit, American Express, Visa or MasterCard.

8.0 Household Member

8.1 Eligibility

Any current member of Campus Recreation can sponsor anyone in their household (who is 18 years old or older) as a household member. The household member must have the same or lesser length of membership than the sponsor. The household member's expiration date cannot go past the expiration date of the sponsor's membership. Household members may not sponsor another member of their household for membership. The current member must accompany the prospective household member(s) to purchase the membership. The current member must show current, active CatCard. The prospective household member(s) must show a picture ID. Upon purchase of the membership, the household member(s) will have one week to purchase a CatCard from the University CatCard Office.

8.2 Membership Terms and Prices

8.2.1 Student Household Member

Household members of University students are eligible to sign up for one current semester at a time. The price per semester is \$75.00.

Membership fees can be paid at the Campus Recreation, Recreation Services (lobby area). Upon purchase of the membership, the member will have one week to purchase a CatCard from the University CatCard Office.

8.2.2 University Employees / Retirees and Affiliate Household Member

Household members of employees / retirees / affiliates are eligible to sign up for one semester at a time or annually. The household member must have the same or lesser length of membership than the employee/retiree or affiliate member. The price per semester is \$95.00, \$250.00 annually or \$330.00 for the annual plus. Membership fees can be paid at the Campus Recreation, Recreation Services (lobby area). Upon purchase of the membership, the household member will have one week to purchase a CatCard from the University CatCard Office.

8.2.3 Alumni Household Member

Household members of alumni are eligible to sign up for an annual membership. The household member must have the same type of membership (or lesser membership) as the current member. Membership fees can be paid at the Campus Recreation, Recreation Services (lobby area). Upon purchase of the membership, the household member will have one week to purchase a CatCard from the University CatCard Office.

8.3 Payment Options

Fees can be paid by cash, check, debit, American Express, Visa, or MasterCard.

University employee's household members can enroll for payroll deduction membership if the employee is qualified (see section 3).

9.0 Semester Previous and Graduating Student Membership

9.1 Eligibility

Students (18 years old or older) who were enrolled at the University of Arizona in the previous semester and are not enrolled in the current semester are eligible for memberships. Students must present their current, active CatCard at time of enrollment. Semester Previous is enrollment in the semester directly prior to the current semester. Previous semester enrollment will be verified. Other proof of previous semester's enrollment may include proof of fees paid.

9.2 Membership Terms and Prices

The membership term is the one semester immediately after the student has stopped taking classes.

The price per term is \$43.56 for spring and fall. Fall and spring semester pricing includes a \$3.56 Campus Recreation Program Fee, of which you can request a Waiver – per term only. For the summer semester the price is \$47.12 for the entire semester or \$23.56 for either summer term. Summer pricing includes a \$3.56 per term Campus Recreation Program Fee, of which you can request a per term, summer Waiver. Guidelines for requesting a waiver and form are available at the Student Recreation Center, Recreation Services (lobby area) and online at <http://CampusRec.arizona.edu>.

9.3 Payment Options

Fees can be paid by cash, check, debit, American Express, Visa or MasterCard.

10.0 Special Summer Student and Non-UA Student Membership

10.1 Eligibility

10.1.1 Non-UA Student Summer Membership

Students (18 years old or older) who were enrolled in another **university** (includes Tucson's Pima Community College) **during the spring semester** but are in Tucson for the summer are eligible for membership. The spring semester enrollment is the semester directly prior to the current summer semester. Students must present their picture identification (driver's license) and **one of either** - their spring semester's 'grade report' **or** spring 'proof of fees paid' at time of membership purchase. The grade report or proof of fees must include the student's name and current spring semester date.

Membership Terms and Prices

The membership term is the University of Arizona current summer semester only.

The price is \$47.12 for the entire semester or \$23.56 for either summer term. Summer pricing includes a \$3.56 per term Campus Recreation Program Fee, of which you can request a per term, summer waiver*. Guidelines for requesting a waiver and form are available at the Student Recreation Center, Recreation Services (lobby area) and online at <http://CampusRec.arizona.edu>. (*see section 1.8 for further information)

10.1.2 In-Coming Transfer, Freshman or Graduate Student

Any incoming transfer, freshman or graduate student, who is in Tucson for the summer Semester, has never attended the UA and is currently registered {registration must be verifiable via (SIS) Student Information System} for the upcoming fall semester (term 4) will be eligible to purchase a summer semester student membership. Summer semester is terms 2 and 3. After registering for the fall semester, new students must secure a CatCard from the CatCard office prior to purchasing a summer membership. Incoming student must show their current/active CatCard in order to access the facility, to access any services, to make any purchases and to make any changes to their current member record.

If an incoming student is 17 years of age or younger, the incoming student will need parent and/or legal guardian's signature on the Membership Contract (or any contract whatsoever) in order to make any purchase.

Membership Terms and Prices

The membership term is the University of Arizona current summer semester only.

For the summer semester the price is \$47.12 for the entire semester or \$23.56 for either summer term. Summer pricing includes a \$3.56 per term Campus Recreation Program Fee, of which you can request a per term, summer waiver*. ([*see section 1.8 for further information](#))

Payment Options

Fees can be paid by cash, check, debit, American Express, Visa or MasterCard.

10.1.3 Special Summer Groups

During the summer semester (terms 2 and 3) there are special summer group memberships that are available to UA Departments for temporary visiting students, adults and minors for summer group swim access only. Contact Recreation Services, Office Supervisor for eligibility, etc. at 626-3396. See special note below relating to minors.

Note: A minor is anyone 17 years of age or younger. Any UA Department with a group of minors requesting Campus Recreation access and/or summer group swim access (after 7pm) must have the Family Recreation Contract (Assumption of Risk and Personal Responsibility User Agreement) completed and on file at Campus Recreation by the minor's parent or legal guardian prior to the payment being processed and the minor accesses Campus Recreation facilities. Minor participants must be escorted by one counselor/chaperone per ten participants and cannot use the weight room or cardiovascular equipment.

11.0 Non-Student Sport Club Participation (NSSCP)

11.1 Eligibility

Each recognized sport club may have NSSCP (18 years old or older) participate with the sport club, not to exceed 10% of the sport club student body. The official sport club representative will provide approval for the NSSCP. Participant access will be sold after the Campus Recreation Assistant Director for Sport Club has approved the list and number of NSSCP. NSSCP must present a picture ID at time of sport club participant purchase. A Temporary Card will be provided if participant does not have a current CatCard at time of purchase. If a Temporary Card is issued, the card and a photo ID must be shown to enter as a Non-Student Sport Club Participant.

11.1.2 Sport Club Requirements

The ASUA and Campus Recreation must recognize the sport club. The sport club must have approved, scheduled practice times for the semester before any NSSCP will be sold. The sport club will be held liable and accountable for damages/injuries caused by or of the NSSCP.

11.2 Participant Terms and Prices

The participant term is one semester ending on the last day of regularly scheduled practice for that sport club. The access to Campus Recreation Facilities is during the regularly scheduled practices and registered events only.

The price per term is \$43.56 for spring and fall and includes a \$3.56 Program Fee per term. For the summer semester the price is \$47.12 for the entire semester or \$23.56 for either summer term. Since the Program Fee assists with the funding of Campus Recreation programs – i.e. Sports Clubs, *participants are not qualified to waive the Program Fee at time of purchase.*

11.3 Payment Options

Fees can be paid by cash, check, debit, American Express, Visa or MasterCard.

12.0 Intramural Sports Non-Student Participants

University of Arizona faculty and staff members may participate in Intramural Sports with a Campus Recreation membership or with an Intramural Participation Card. The Intramural Participation Card is available for \$30.00 through the Intramural Sports Office. All fees are paid at Recreation Services (lobby area).

13.0 Guest Passes

13.1 Eligibility

Guests must be 18 years of age or older and have a picture identification indicating age.

13.2 Member Sponsored Guests

Current Campus Recreation members may sponsor guests at any time. The member must accompany their guest at time of guest pass purchase. The guest accepts the terms and conditions stated in the Assumption of Risk and Personal Responsibility User Agreement for guests that is completed and signed at time of purchase. Campus Recreation reserves the right to refuse admittance or sale of passes and to revoke guest pass privileges when necessary.

13.2.1 Family Recreation

On weekends (Saturday and Sunday) and University holidays (from 10:30am to close), current members may bring members of their family who are 17 years old or younger into the facility for \$3.00 per minor guest per day (price increase effective summer 2008 semester). Please note that there may be occasions when access times are subject to change at the discretion of Campus Recreation. The member must be constantly with their guests. Children may use everything except the weight room and cardio equipment. One adult may supervise up to three children. Please see facility policies for additional information.

13.3 University Sponsored Guests

Individuals participating in university sponsored events (conferences, seminars, camps, performances, etc.) may purchase a guest pass. The guest must bring proof of their involvement in the event, such as: receipt for conference registration, letter from program sponsor, nametag-indicating dates of conference, etc.

For groups, please contact Campus Recreation, Recreation Services, Office Supervisor (626-3396) for processing information in advance in order to expedite the purchase of passes. See section 13.5 for Guest Pass terms and pricing.

13.4 University of Arizona Alumni (that are verified UA graduates via SIS – Student Information System) may purchase a One Day Pass for \$7.00; Five Day Pass for \$30.00 or a Ten Day Pass for \$50.00. Five and ten day passes are not consecutive days passes.

13.5 Guest Pass Terms and Prices

Three guest passes are available:

One Day Pass for \$7.00; Five Day Pass for \$30.00; Ten Day Pass for \$50.00

Five and ten day passes are not consecutive days passes.

13.6 Payment Options

Passes are purchased at Recreation Services (lobby area). Payment may be made by cash, check, debit, American Express, Visa, or MasterCard.
