Campus Recreation Program Fee Waiver Policy

1.0 General Information

The Student Recreation Center (SRC) opened in August of 1990. While students voted via a student referendum in 1985 to fund construction of the facility by paying a \$25.00 per term fee, no provision was made to fund the recreational programs that operate in the facility.

A referendum for a Campus program fee that is continuous and refundable, with CPI (Consumer Price Index) increases annually was presented to the students to vote on during the student elections held March 6 & 7, 2002. The students approved the referendum and the University began collecting a \$3.00 fee in August 2002.

The per term program fee will support recreational programs, campus recreation student wage increases, sport clubs and facility needs of the Department of Campus Recreation.

2.0 Waiver Process

Students eligible for a Program Fee Waiver are CESL, Semester Previous, Extended University, ASU/NAU, Non-UA (summer only) and Medical (summer only).

Waiver Process

The student **must request that the \$3.34 (per term) Program Fee be waived at the time the membership is purchased at the Department of**

Campus Recreation Business Office for the current term. The 'Request for Campus Recreation Program Fee Waiver' form must be completed and include the student's name, student ID number and mailing address.

3.0 Waiver Process Addendum

If you receive a waiver and then decide to sign up for any programs (activity and/or pass) during the current term, requires a payment of the \$3.34 Program Fee plus a \$9.00 Processing Fee is required at the time you purchase the activity and/or pass.
