



CHALLENGE PROGRAM-ROPES COURSE Participants Informational Sheet

To insure that you have a safe and incredible experience with the University of Arizona's Challenge Program (UACP), here are a few recommendations:

1. **Attire** -Wear comfortable clothing. Dress according to the weather. The program requires moderate physical activity, so it's best to dress comfortably to allow you to move freely. We also recommend a comfortable, athletic-type shoe, and for your safety, no open-toe shoes or footwear which may restrain your physical ability are allowed.
2. **Jewelry** - For your safety and that of others, we cannot allow participants to wear jewelry (i.e. watches, bracelets, earrings and any other piercing) on the course. This also includes any sharp and/or metal objects (i.e. pens, etc.) that you may normally carry with you. Please do not wear these items on the day of the activity, as you will be asked to remove them for the duration of the program and we are not responsible for these items.
3. **Sun Protection** - We will spend the day outdoors; therefore sun protection is extremely important. We have sunscreen available on the course, but if you have allergies or prefer a certain brand, please bring that along with you. A hat or cap, as well as a long sleeve shirt are also recommended.
4. **WATER!** - Keeping your body hydrated is very important. We have a water fountain on-site, but we strongly recommend that you bring your water bottle to access throughout the day.
5. **Food** - Food is not supplied at the course; so for a full day of programs, please make the proper arrangements. Groups are welcome to bring their lunches or visit nearby restaurants.
6. **Disabilities/Accommodations-** The Challenge Course has accessible facilities and elements. If you or anyone in your group needs any special accommodations or additional services, please contact Richard Romero at (520) 621-8710 prior to your event.
